## Plato Gold Corp. Hits Further Gold Intersections In Northern Ontario

Toronto, November 22, 2005 – Plato Gold Corp. (PGC: TSX-V) is pleased to announce the latest results of its diamond drill program on two of its properties along the Destor Porcupine Fault Zone, east of Timmins, Ontario.

Drilling on the property in Guibord Township, some 5 km southeast of Apollo Gold's Black Fox Project, east of Matheson, Ontario has been completed with a total of 15 drill holes totaling 3201 metres in length. Following are preliminary assay results:

The news release of October 14, 2005 highlighted gold assay results from the first 5 Guibord holes which included 21.60 metres grading 0.84 grams of gold per tonne and a 5 metre section that assayed 2.70 grams per tonne including a one metre section that assayed 6.65 grams gold per tonne within the 5 metre section in hole GP 01. These drill results continue to expand the extent of known gold mineralization on the Guibord property. The Quartz Vein Zone which was originally discovered in 1989 has been expanded to several hundred metres in length and remains open.

Eight holes totaling 1816 metres have been drilled on Plato's Marriott property. Three more holes totaling 1160 metres are planned for the Marriott property for this stage of the program. No assay results are available yet. The program for Guibord and Marriott should total some 6177 metres. The program being conducted is based on a review and recommendations made by Watts Griffis and McOuat (WGM) in a 43-101 report on the Plato properties.

The program is being managed by Richard W. Risto, B.Sc., M.Sc., P. Geo. who is the Corporation's Qualified Person and he has reviewed this press release. Swastika Laboratories Ltd. of Swastika, Ontario is the primary assay laboratory. Plato's program for quality control entails Swastika select one sample in every 20 routine samples and send to SGS Laboratories for check assaying.
